



Taize Prayer Service



Epiphany Chalking the Doors
Epiphany (also known as Twelfth Night or Three Kings Day) marks the occasion of a time-honored Christian tradition of "chalking the doors." The formula for the ritual — is simple: take chalk of any color and write the following above the entrance of your home: 20 + C + M + B + 23 (current year).

The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Malchior, and Balthazar — who came to visit Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, Christus mansionem benedicat: May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the cross

This inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless those homes so marked and that He stay with those who dwell therein throughout the entire year. It is an easy tradition to adopt whereby we dedicate our year to God from its very onset, asking His blessing on our homes and on all who live, work, or visit them
