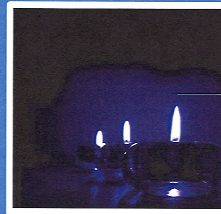
The holidays are here. If you have ever experienced a loss, it doesn't

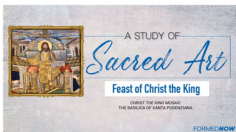

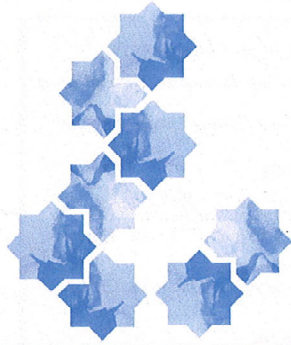

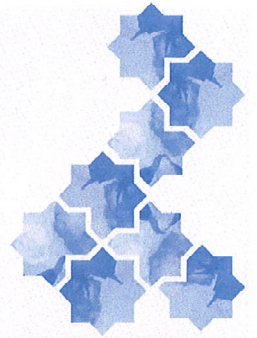
