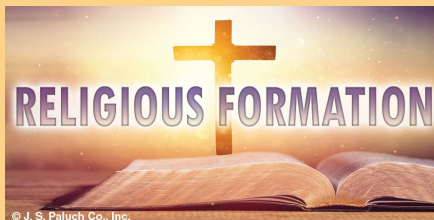

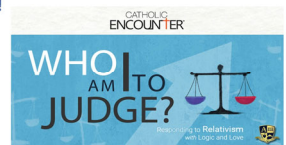

## Summer Domestic Church Challenge

Keeping Jesus at the center of your life- in rest and in play- at home and away.

The Church has long called the family “domestic church,” because it is composed of individuals living out their baptism together. Let our homes become a place that fosters holiness, for we are all called to be saints.

**CCC 2725** We pray as we live, because we live as we pray. The “spiritual battle” of the Christian’s new life is inseparable from prayer.

1. Find or create an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Learn about this devotion and it’s 12 promises, including peace in the family.
2. Keep a rosary in your car to pray on the beginning of vacation or even on trips across town.
3. Plan trips with Mass in mind, eager to uncover the treasures and gifts of other parishes. Note what is the same and different from your home parish.
4. Let playtime be teachable moments of your Christian faith and values, practicing charity towards others when you win in sports, including everyone in an activity, pointing out the goodness and virtues of characters in a movie.
5. Keep pictures of special family moments on the frig, reminding you to stop and pray for the gift of family each time you grab a drink or bite to eat.
6. Create art from shells and sticks and stones and other things found in nature, thanking God for the gift of creation.
7. Play and pray in the summer rain- laugh, sing, dance, and hug- all in front of the statue of the blessed Mother in your yard.

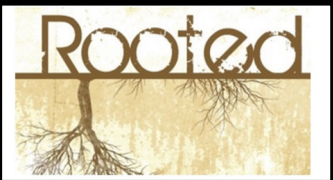

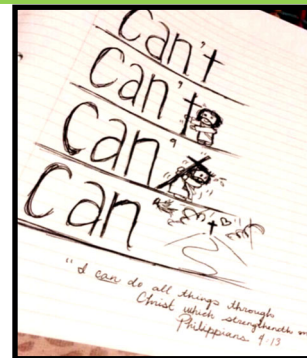

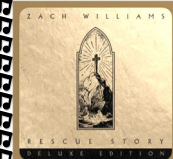

## The Days Are Coming

Separation, isolation, and hostility are terrible things. We are, sadly, too familiar with all of them in our modern life, whether we look at world events or events in our own neighborhoods and families. All three readings today refer to these same sad human conditions.

The prophet Jeremiah describes world conditions as if the people of his time were sheep who had been scattered by poor leadership and corrupt shepherds. But “the days are coming,” he assures us (Jeremiah 23:5), when a new shepherd, a just king, will come. We meet that king in the second reading and the Gospel. Paul reminds us in the Letter to the Ephesians that all divisions can now cease in Christ Jesus, who has brought us together through his blood. In Mark’s Gospel we see Jesus himself, looking with pity on those searching for him as if they were sheep without a shepherd.

**Gospel** — When Jesus saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, and he began to teach them many things (Mark 6:30-34).

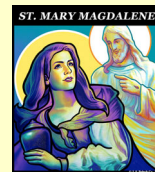

**“The Legacy of a Loving Family”**

A favorite set of childhood memories revolves around our family’s annual reunions. My grandmother had ten brothers and sisters. They called themselves “The Dirty Dozen.” Somebody couldn’t count. All the spouses, all the grandchildren, cousins, aunts and uncles. I guess. We’d fill a state park and draw a crowd with our fun. The best part? When the sun finally set, we’d gather around a cooking fire, and the oldest members of the family would tell their stories. Familiar or not, that made each trip, giving us a sense of belonging and identity that was refreshing and lingers still—memories that connected me to our legacy, allowing me to own what was handed down by others who loved me, too.

“For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you.” St. Paul enjoyed an unusual relationship with the Savior. The apostles—Peter, Andrew, James, John and the rest—had known Jesus, personally and well. On the road to Damascus, Paul met the Lord in a remarkable challenge of wills that left Saul in the dust, and lifted Paul to a life of service and sacrifice. And that knowledge he passed on to us, his Spiritual heirs, and heirs of God.

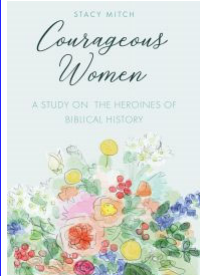
