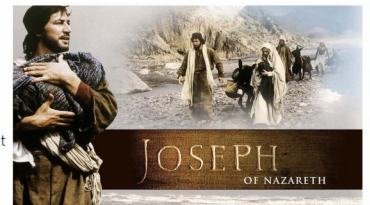

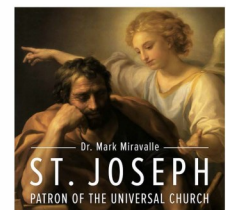

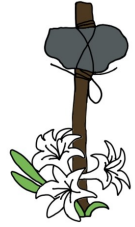
Pray for the women and their children receiving services and pray for the volunteers that mentor women, give baby showers to new mothers, and respond with love to those in crisis entering the doors.

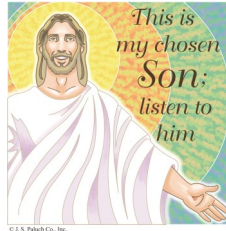
