## Lord, Send Out Your Spirit

In today's responsorial psalm the Church sings out: "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth." All three readings describe how God has answered that prayer already.

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles and in the Gospel passage from John, we read of astonishing events that called cowering disciples to step out of hiding and proclaim news that would condemn them and change the world forever! In the second reading Paul's words reach out into the future to us: "we were all given to drink of one Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:13).

It is our task to truly pray today's psalm response. Let us together beg the Holy Spirit to renew the earth by renewing the Church, sending many more men and women to serve in its various ministries.

## Stewardship

### “The Gift of Intangible Blessings”

A prospective buyer of an established business will gather a great many pieces of information: client lists, profit and loss statements, inventory records, and so on. “Let me see the books,” one might say, and the seller—prepared for these conversations, opens them up. Discussions concerning assets are expected. At some point, key players discuss *intangibles*, as well. “Talk to me about good will. What is the firm’s reputation? How do employees feel about the proposed change of ownership?” Intangible concerns are critical aspects in practically every transaction, in any relationship. And though, when we think of assets, gifts and blessings, we often muse on the tangible, God suggests the intangibles may be of greater importance.

Psalm 103, a psalm of David, begins with these words: “Bless the Lord, all my being, bless his holy name! Bless the Lord, my soul; do not forget all the gifts of God.” A casual reading of those two verses conjures mental images of jobs, relationships, health, houses, cars, money in the bank, and homes and offices full of possessions. The remaining verses in the psalm reveal other truths altogether- “the gifts of God” are shown, at least in this instance, to be largely *intangible* blessings. And a list of them is extensive: forgiveness, healing, love, compassion, youth, righteousness, justice, mercy, grace, patience, kindness, wisdom, favor and protection. After all, there may be nothing quite as tangible as the sense of peace and comfort such generosity engenders in those blessed of God.

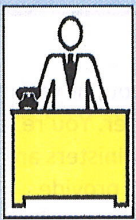

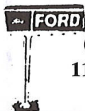
