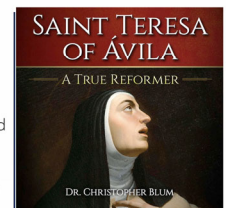

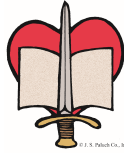

Gifts

In today's readings, we discover that material wealth alone does not keep us from discipleship. We will see that there are other gifts more important than material wealth, but even so, it is how we use our gifts that matters most.

Today's scriptures point to the value of the gifts of wisdom, trusting in God, and letting our actions reflect the love of God from within. It is not gold that causes us to fall, but rather the desire for gold above all other things. From the readings in Wisdom and Hebrews, we find the source of God's gifts in our lives. Wisdom is more valuable than worldly possessions. In Hebrews, we are challenged to look at our own values and admit honestly what controls our lives.

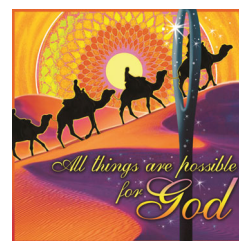

All Things Are Possible For God

Wis 7:7-11 / Heb 4:12-13 / Mk 10:17-30

“For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God.” Jesus says that it is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God. These are hard words. Is He saying that a person with wealth cannot get into Heaven, because a camel certainly can NOT fit through the eye of a needle! Or is He simply reminding us that we are not going to get to Heaven of our own accord...? If God wills a camel to fit through the eye of a needle, it WILL fit. Obviously, God wants us in Heaven with Him, but our wealth and worldliness impede the path. As missionary disciples who seek to be FULLY alive, we can't fall into the trap of putting our trust in the riches of the world — we must put our wealth to the service of the Lord. God can use the blessings of this world to bring us closer to Him, but we have to cooperate willingly and completely. In Stewardship, we place God first because all things that are good came from Him. He has given all that is good to us to use for His glory. Where is our treasure? Wherever our treasure is, there our hearts will be. Where is our hearts?




